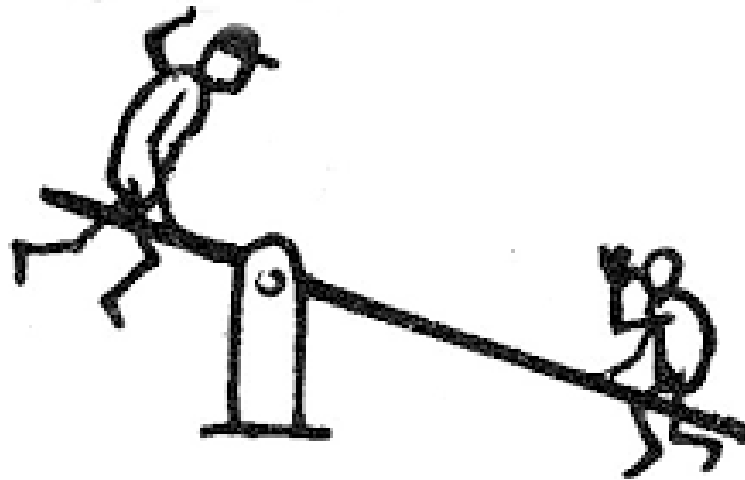


12 December 2014. First European Conference of Trade Union Services for Migrants. 200 delegates from 45 trade union confederations, from 19 EU countries, attended the ETUC Conference in Brussels. They shared experiences, they learned from each others, they built connections. The trade voice arrived loud to the the European institutions and employers associations demanding for greater respect of migrants' rights and a more social dialogue in the EU policies in the migration field.



14-16 April 2014 in Turin, Network Building Conference. Three days of work to set our operational rules. 80 people from the trade union movement and social enterprises will write the operational rules of the network, will agree on its ethical values, will design a weportal and a Eu campaign for integration of migrants. The Conference is organised by the ICT-ILO: Programme here.




