## Toolkit test

- Toolkit tested on 3 occasions
  - Test 1: Company donut
    - Group of 6 reps, various sectors (banking, food, organic waste processing, steel, ...)
  - Test 2: Company donut + economic traffic light
    - 1 rep from a company producing materials (e.g. for isolation of houses)
  - Test 3: self-assessment checklists on economic issues
    - Group of 10 reps, various sectors (chemistry, petroleum, care, social workplace, food)



# Test results

- Test 1:
  - No questionnaire but group discussion on company donut
  - Main conclusions:
    - Results match assessment of reps, usable in different sectors
    - Missing: questions on nightwork/shift work, organisation of the workplace itself
    - Purpose of the tool is clear
- Test 2:
  - Questionnaire used
    - Average score for each part
      - Purpose 5/5
      - Comprehensiveness 4.67/5
      - Usefullness 4.75/5



# Test results

- Test 3:
  - Part of questionnaire used
  - 9 out of 10 responded
  - Reps could choose from 6 checklists
    - Current economic situation / Future prospects 8 | Concurrence position 7
    - Innovation policy 6 | CSR policy 5 | Relationships with subcontracters suppliers 4
  - Link between checklists and transition

  - Language was clear
  - No ambigious words / sentences

- Few questions were not applicable
- No important questions missing
- I would like to use similar checklists in the future
- Results of the checklists are usable in social dialogue
